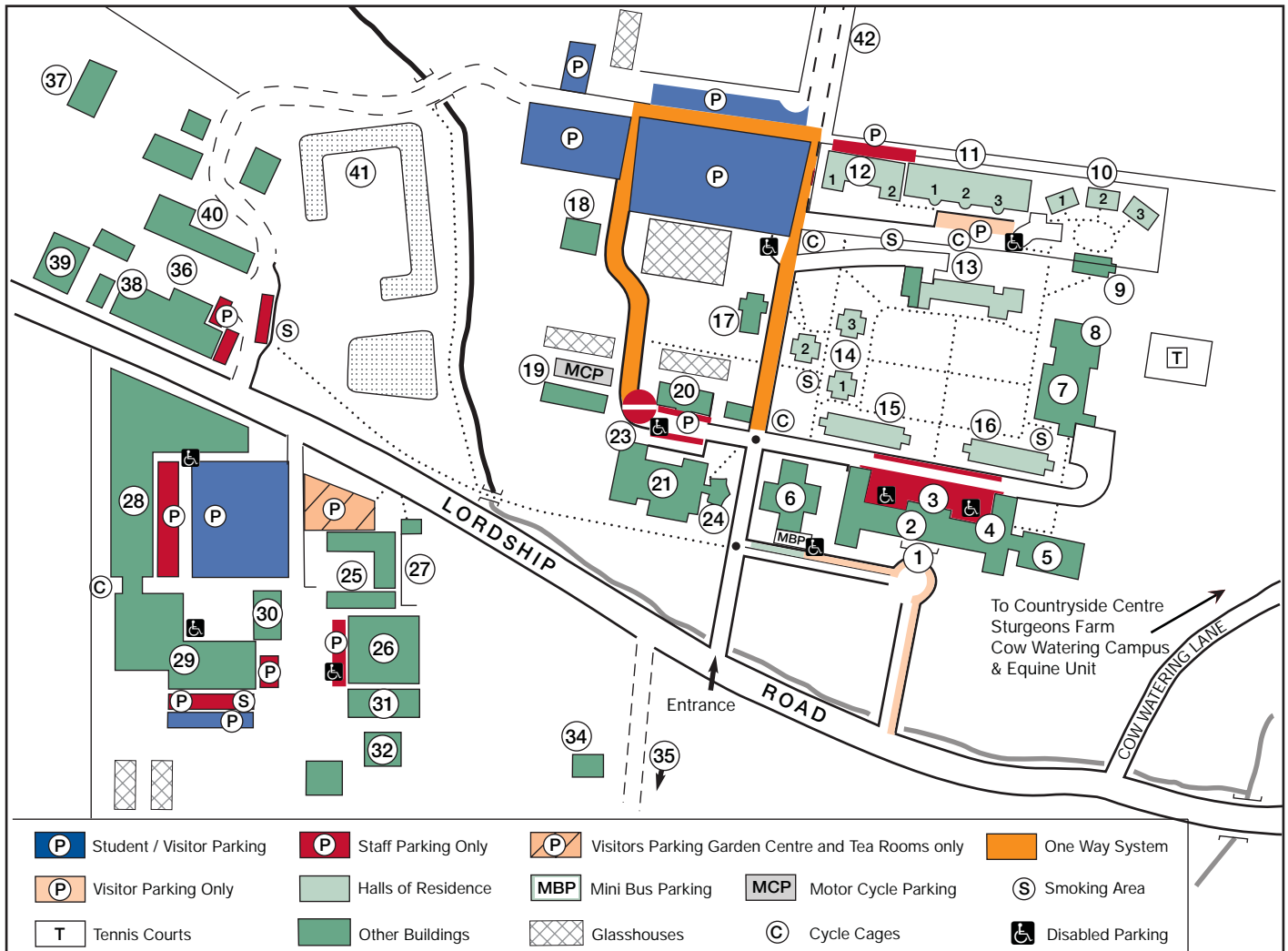

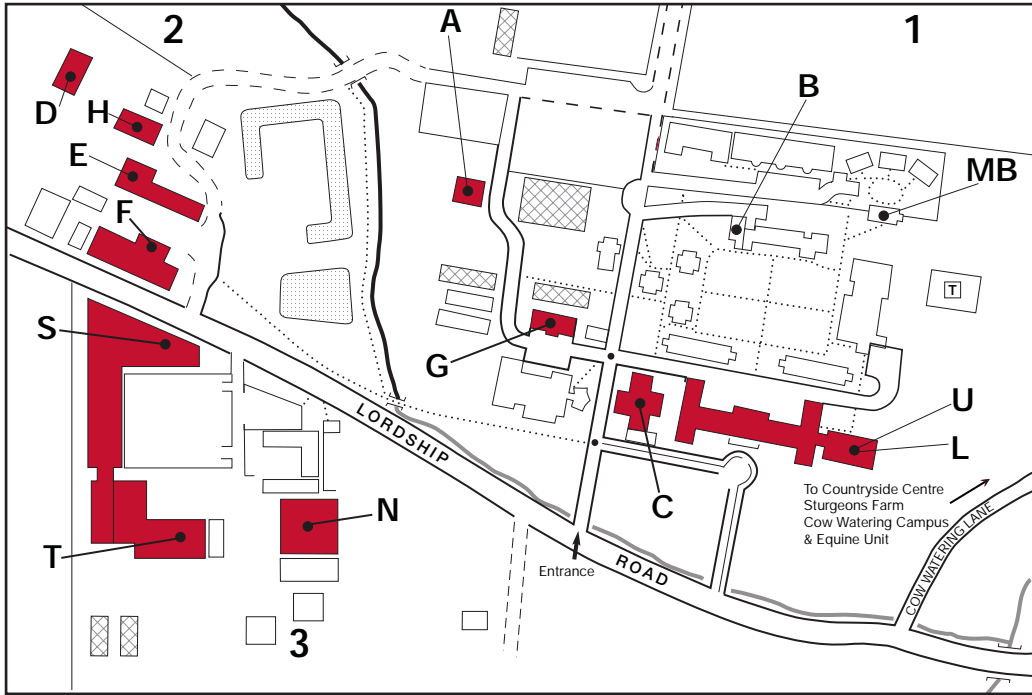

Car Parking Regulations

| a. Students may only park in the designated student car parks (shaded blue). Other drivers must park in the appropriate designated areas. | f. Vehicle permits must be displayed in a prominent position on the windscreen. | administration costs will be charged to the owner of the vehicle. |
| b. All student vehicles must be registered online and display a permit. Staff vehicles must display a permit available from the Property Office. Visitor Parking Permits are available from Main Reception. | g. A 5 mph speed limit applies to the main campus roads. | i. Any vehicle brought onto the campus must be insured and taxed. |
| c. Students whose vehicles are parked in staff or visitor car parks will be fined. | h. It is an offence to cause undue vehicle noise when driving on the College grounds. | m. Students' visitors bringing cars onto the campus should be asked to park in the designated student car parks, and not on the staff or visitor's car park. Visitors must obtain a temporary vehicle pass from Student Services. |
| d. There must be no parking along any College roads, to enable free movement of traffic. | i. Vehicles must not be left on the car parks during the vacation unless permission has been obtained from the Property Office. | n. Vehicles must not be driven recklessly or driven onto paths or grassed areas. |
| e. The one-way system must be strictly observed. | j. Vehicle repairs must not be carried out on the car parks. | |
| | k. The College reserves the right to dispose of abandoned vehicles after a period of 3 months. Any costs incurred plus | Drivers in breach of any car parking or vehicle regulations maybe subject to a fine and/or a vehicle campus ban. |
